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Present Simple Tense



We use the present simple tense to talk about regular or habitual actions. It is the most basic and common tense in English and it's really important to understand well.



Form

Subject + Verb (s,es) + Object

Singular subject + verb(s,es) + Object

Plural subject + verb(~~s~~) + Object

Examples

He **plays** guitar every day.

We **play** volleyball every day.



Present Simple Tense



Form (Negative)

Subject + don't/doesn't + Verb + Object

Examples



I **don't** like tea.
She **doesn't** like coffee.



Form (Question)

Do/Does + Subject + Verb + Object?

Examples




Do you **go** to school every day?

Do they **watch** film every evening?




Present Simple Tense




 Time adverbs used with the present tense



Always เสมอ	Every day ทุกวัน
Often บ่อยๆ	Every week ทุกสัปดาห์
Sometime บ่อยครั้ง	Usually ปกติ
Once a week สัปดาห์ละ 1 ครั้ง	




When should we use the present simple tense?

1. Regular habits and daily routines
Examples : Bas usually gets up at 6 o'clock. She does not play tennis every day. 
2. Feeling
Examples : I love watching TV. He does not like steak. 
3. Facts
Examples : The earth revolves around the sun. Water does not boil at 20 degrees. 


Present Simple Tense

When should we use the present simple tense?



4. Timetables and schedules

Examples : The train **leaves** at 4 p.m.
The shop **does not remain** open after ten.



5. Opinions and states of mind

Examples : He **does not agree** with you.
I **think** he is a wonderful student.
